



Meanwhile, our team took her to the bank the next day and talked to the branch manager. Tried to solve all their problems, then the woman was not educated due to which she was unable to even fill the form. She was given support by filling her form and was also helped in giving the paper documents. With this our support, she got Rs 1.5 lakh. The day was transferred to his account due to which he told me that because of AGRAGATI today I have received my money, for this he expressed his gratitude and we felt very happy after doing this.



Success Story	Located in Ramgarh, an incubatee of AGRAGATI, trains and equips low-income youth with financial, entrepreneurial and leadership skills that will help him combat poverty. He holds 2 3-hour training sessions with a week's gap. The youth introduced to concepts such book-keeping, money management, management and savings. To ensure long-lasting sustainable impact, AGRAGATI selects youth ambassadors from among the trained youth who become the primary point of contact for a group of youth in the village. Brahmdev Mahto comes from a very poor family in Ramgarh Gobardhara Village. Started as a security guard in Ranchi, working hard to provide for his family. With the help of one of our Field Mobilizer we got introduced to Brahmdev. Field Mobilizer informed him about our various offerings and he got interested in one of our entrepreneurship training programs. We have supported through Counselling, Mobile Repairing Training through RUDSETI, Silli, Preparation of business plan, Market linkages and mentoring support. After that Brahmdev Mahto recognizing his potential, Brahmdev decided to pursue mobile repairing training. After that as in the initial stage of his startup he has invested INR 25,000 for some equipment purchasing. He feels motivated and empowered even in a stressful situation due to our support. Currently, Brahmdev is self-employed, contributing not only to his family but also creating opportunities for others. Brahmdev's success serves as a positive example, inspiring others in the community to pursue skill development for self-sufficiency.
